The Pub and its Facilities

The Carpenters Arms stands prominently on the main road and is the only pub in the village of Fiskerton and has off road parking for c.50 vehicles. The trading area comprises of a public bar with a pool table, lounge, dining/restaurant area with 64 covers, which also opens onto an outdoor patio area with a further 20 covers, so can easily cater for large parties and functions. The pub also benefits from a substantial grassed beer garden with additional seating which is very popular, along with a small covered area to the side. The beer cellar is located on the ground floor along with a fully equipped commercial kitchen.
